Sharon, here's a few ideas for your upcoming tablet needs, peripheral devices, and endpoint management recommendations. As a security principle, you should activate endpoint management on the devices before issuing them to end users, as these are the town's devices and security of information should remain top priority. I've shaken out 3 levels of options, with add-ons below. I'm working with a limit of \$700 for the devices & add-ons, something in that range should be more than enough to have all town members connecting and working efficiently.

Some of these devices come with peripherals (keyboards, pens, covers), some don't. That selection can be made later once the device is determined. I also recommend ordering screen protectors for them.

BestBuy (Geek Squad) 2-year \$70-\$100 (for ~ \$250 device) & 3-year \$150 - \$180 (for ~ \$500 device)

Device management can be done with [Google's Endpoint Management](#) for all devices. It's not a direct anti-virus with active scanning, but it helps manage the device's ability to stay secure from malware, and comes with the version of Google Suite the town already has. Office 365 can be purchased for all devices, Android, Mac, or Windows; I do want to try to test using the [Office plugin for Google](#) to see how well it works, but if it's time to pull the trigger, let's do it.

My thoughts would be to aim for one of the mid-level devices. Get something that will be able to handle what's coming in the next few years so you won't have to replace it soon. Basically, with electronics, you get what you pay for; and you'll always pay a bit more for Apple stuff.
